DRUG TESTING: Competitors at Record Status tournaments are liable for drug testing and must comply if approached to give samples ; **a refusal will be treated as a positive result.** Each Archer must signify consent to this on the entry form. (Parent/guardian to sign in the case of under 18 junior entries).

JUNIORS : A parent (or Guardian) must agree to accompany any junior, (under 18 years of age), entering the event, or must nominate another adult where indicated on the entry form, (or provide confirmation of the nominated adult in writing).

NB: ARCHERS WILL BE EXCLUDED IF THESE REQUIREMENTS ARE NOT ADHERED TO - IF IN DOUBT CONTACT THE TOURNAMENT ORGANISER FOR CLARIFICATION.
