This competition will be shot in two details, with up to two archers per detail, totaling a maximum of four per target. Please consult the club web site for the latest information – For the WA 720 competition Compound archers (at 50m) will use a 6 zone 80cm target face with 2,3, or 4 faces per boss – all other bow types at 50m, 60m, and 70m use 122cm faces.

Head-to-Head elimination rounds will start at 16 archers or below, depending on entry numbers.

Entrants must declare their Archery GB membership number on the entry form and membership cards may be required when registering on the day. Failure to do so will result in you not being allowed to shoot.

The Blandy-Jenkins field is a shared playing field; as such, lost arrows cannot remain unaccounted for. To minimise the risk of undetectable arrows being left on the sports field, archers are encouraged not to use all-carbon arrows. Archers wishing to use all-carbon arrows are required to indicate on the entry form, and to identify their equipment to the organisers at registration and also on departure.

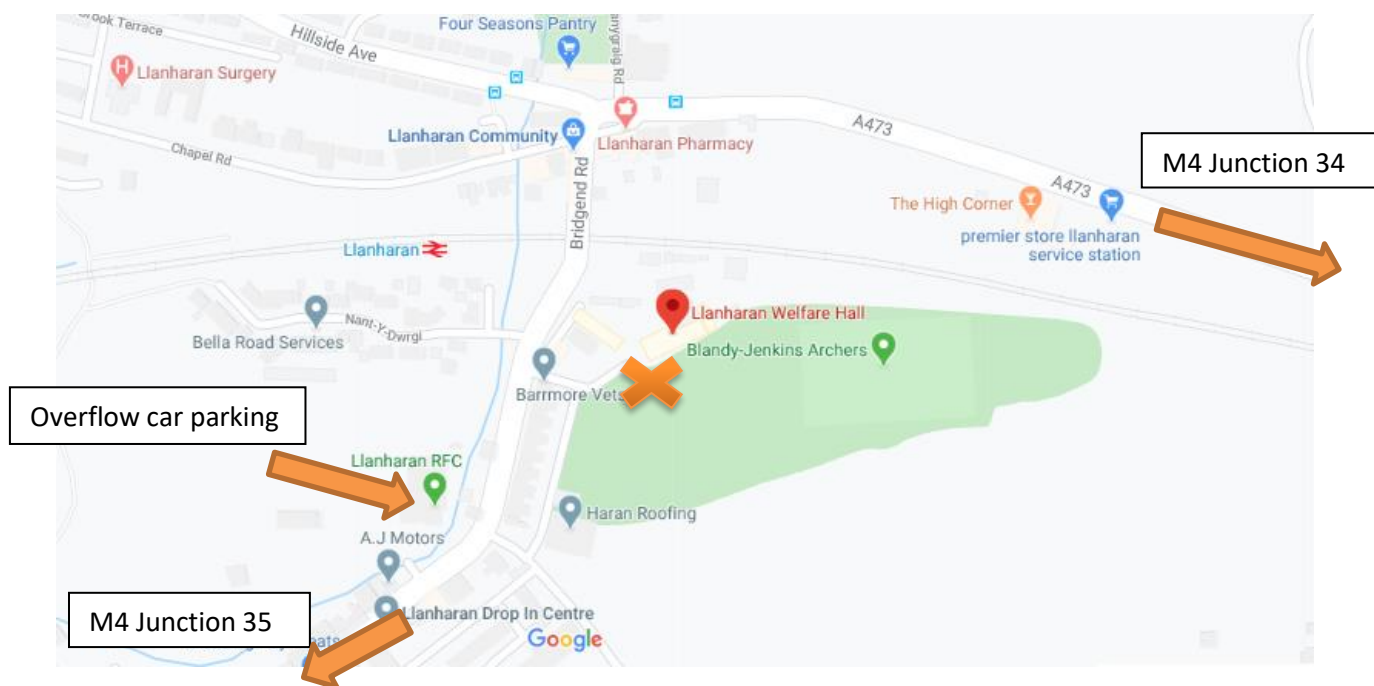
## DIRECTIONS
