The Welsh Archery Association (WAA) are very pleased to announce that the Inter-County Championship will this year be hosted by the Glamorgan Archery Association (GAA) on Saturday September 17th 2022 at Blandy-Jenkins Archers, Llanharan CF72 9RA.

The tournament is designed to give club archers in Wales the opportunity to compete in a high level team event and provide a stepping stone to national and international competition.

The tournament will be followed by the WAA AGM.

Covid-19

Most Covid restrictions are lifted in Wales, therefore normal rules of shooting and tournaments apply. If anything changes before this date, then communications will be sent out. However, we request that you do not attend if you have tested positive in the 7 days prior to the event.

Format

Each county can enter teams of (up to) 4 archers, comprising two male & two female (with the top 3 to score) in any / all of the 8 categories listed below.

Categories: Senior Recurve, Senior Compound, Senior Barebow, Senior Longbow
Junior Recurve, Junior Compound, Junior Barebow, Junior Longbow

Senior Archers in all Categories will shoot:	WA 720 (6 dozen arrows: Recurve & Longbow 70m/122cm Face, Compound 50m/80cm Face, Barebow 50m/122cm Face)
Junior Archers in all Categories will shoot:	WA 720 60m for U18 Metric 122 - 50m for U16 Metric 122 - 40m for U14 Metric 122 - 30m for U12 All junior rounds to be shot on a 122cm face.

(Note this event is a closed competition and will be eligible for Welsh Records only)

A "levelling" clause will apply on the day by allowing a 2nd and/or 3rd score to be added to a team of one and/or two archers. That score will equal the lowest score shot by an archer in that category. This will enable counties to enter more than one team in a category if they so wish. In this case, team members must be nominated before the match

Timings

The timings for the day are:

11:00 Team managers' meeting with organiser & judges
11:30 Assembly
11:45 Sighters
12:00 Commence shooting

Carbon Arrows

- The Blandy-Jenkins field is a shared playing field; as such, lost arrows cannot remain unaccounted for. To minimise the risk of undetectable arrows being left on the sports field, archers are encouraged not to use all-carbon arrows. Archers wishing to use all-carbon arrows are required to identify their equipment to the organisers at registration and also on departure.

Shooting

- Method 2 will be used to control shooting, i.e. each detail will shoot timed ends of six arrows.

Scoring

- As we will be shooting Metric Rounds, 10 zone scoring will apply.
- In the event of a tie, the number of golds (10s) will be used to determine a winner.
- Although the winning county in each category will be determined by adding together the top 3 actual scores, the overall competition will NOT be determined by just adding all the actual scores together. Instead, the winning county in each category will be awarded 5 points, 2nd will get 4 points, 3rd gets 3 points, 4th gets 2 points and 5th get 1 point. The winning team gets 5 points even if not all counties compete in that category. In the event of a tie the number of 1st then 2nd places would be used.

Eligibility

1. All archers taking part must be member of the WAA at the time of the competition.
2. No Senior archer who has represented Wales or GB or been a member of a Welsh or GB squad, in the 12 months prior to the date of competition will be eligible to compete in the discipline they were a team/squad member for.
3. No Junior archer who has been a member of a GB team will be eligible to compete in the discipline they were a team member for. Junior archers who have been members of a GB squad, or a Welsh team/squad, will be eligible.
4. Preference should be given to archers who have not been members of the Welsh squad in the 12 months prior to the date of the competition.
5. Outside the eligibility rules above, the individual Counties are responsible for setting their own criteria for team selection.

The number of teams likely to be entered should be advised to the tournament organiser as soon as possible. Full team details, including D.O.B. for juniors, to be provided no later than 13th September 2022.
